Dear PCS Families,

I hope everyone is having a joyful and restful summer break. I am excited to welcome our returning families and extend a warm greeting to those joining our school community for the first time.



Information for the 2024-2025 school year:

We have many new and exciting things happening this school year. Below you will find information on our afterschool partnership with Sarah Heinz House, PowerSchool—our new student information system, our upcoming events, and updates from the PCS Parent and Family Group.

Please help me in giving a warm welcome to Ms. Shannon Keating, our new Social Worker for Provident. Ms. Keating will play a crucial role in supporting students, families, and school staff to ensure students' academic and social success.

School Supplies - Students will need their own personal supplies in a pencil box: child scissors, crayons, colored pencils, pencils, 2 large erasers. We ask that families purchase either a drawstring bag or a smaller type of book bag, as the lockers do not close if the book bag is larger. Your child's teacher will send a supply list specific to their classroom if one is necessary the first week of school.

Important Reminders:


- Our uniform guidelines have not changed; however, I included a picture below for you to reference for your back-to-school shopping.
- We will once again focus our efforts on improving school attendance, as

research shows attendance is directly correlated to student achievement. The "limit" for days absent with a parent note is 10. After the 10th absence, a doctor's/medical excuse is required for each additional absence. Please monitor your attendance carefully this school year, and let's work together to get your child to school daily.

- For educational trips during the school year, remember to complete a <u>Pre-Approved Absence Request form</u>.
- Students who take medication at school, please remember that
 medication CANNOT be brought to the school by your child, and
 medication orders are required each year. Even if your child had
 medication at school last year, updated medication orders from your
 child's doctor are still required for the start of school.

Finally, be on the look out for more back-to-school information, including teacher assignments, in early August. I look forward to seeing everyone in just a few short weeks.

AFTERSCHOOL CARE

Sarah Heinz House Afterschool Care - PCS Dismissal is at 3:40 pm. Afterschool care, for those who need it, will be provided at Sarah Heinz House. The afterschool care runs until 6:00 pm, and there are additional programs offered from 6:00 pm-9:00 pm. Their facility is just down the street from our school and the PCS van will transport students who are registered for the afterschool program to



students who are registered for the afterschool program to the Sarah Heinz House. Afterschool care will not begin until September 3rd and they do end their program in mid-May.

Important Action Required: You must register through Sarah Heinz House if you want your child to participate in their afterschool programs. The fee for the entire year is \$25 and registration must occur through their website. Details about the program will be posted the last week in July and registration will open August 1st. It is recommended that you register as soon as possible after registration opens.





INTRODUCING: POWERSCHOOL

Technology System Updates: We are excited to share that we have upgraded our Student Information System (SIS) to PowerSchool! You will receive a notification email with instructions on how to access PowerSchool.



This email will contain an access code and password for each of your enrolled students, allowing you to create an account and link your student(s). Please be on the lookout for these emails, as they are crucial for managing your child's educational information. More information will be provided on PowerSchool in the upcoming weeks. Thank you for your cooperation and support during this transition.

This new SIS will serve as our one-stop-shop which means ClassTag will no longer be used for the 2024-2025 school year. Instead, we will utilize Schoology for all parent-teacher communications.
