

Hello PCS West Families,

I hope your summer is going great! I wanted to update you on the exciting things that have been happening over the summer. The greenhouse, which was purchased because of a grant PCS received from the Sisters of St. Joseph, is built and will provide a lot of hands-on learning experiences for students in the



Fall. The items from the Dick's Sporting Goods Grant that we received last year have also arrived. The grant helped us purchase two basketball hoops for outside, kickballs, 2 pickleball sets, 2 badminton sets, and 2 cornhole games. Our Sensory Garden has a new sensory board and our wildflower garden is in full bloom!

Important Upcoming Dates:

August 19th - I am hoping to see you at our Back to School Night on August 19th at 6:30 pm. Information will be shared about the upcoming school year. The nurse, special education department, technology, teachers and principal will be available to answer any questions you may have. Families will be able to tour the school and students can visit their classroom and find their locker.



September 11th - Meet the Teacher Night will begin at 6:30 PM. Teachers will conduct a presentation in their classrooms about what to expect during the upcoming school year.

Upcoming for next year:

School Supplies: Students will need their own personal supplies in a pencil box: child scissors, crayons, colored pencils, pencils, 2 large erasers. We ask

that families purchase either a drawstring bag or a smaller type of bookbag, as the lockers do not close if the bookbag is larger. Your child's teacher will send a supply list specific to their classroom if one is necessary the first week of school.

School Uniforms: Provident Charter School no longer contracts with Schoolbelles. Uniforms can be purchased at local and online stores that sell uniform pieces.

Provident Charter School will have a new Student Information System for the 2024-2025 school year, which will replace ALMA. Our new student information system is called **Powerschool**. This new system will have some additional features to help our school run even more efficiently. As a PCS family, you will be receiving information about how to log-in and utilize this new system at the start of the school year.

We are working on getting a YMCA before and after school care program finalized for the start of the 2024-2025 school year. More information will be provided at a later date.

PCS West will host Virtual Parent & Family Group meetings monthly at the start of the school year. The group will be looking to create a formal board and to establish 501(c)3 status this school year. Families will also be asked if they would consider being a part of the initial PCS West Parent & Family board, perhaps as a President, Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer. Please consider volunteering for one of these crucial roles.

Parents are asked to complete Act 372 Forms when transportation is being requested. Communication regarding these forms has been sent to families. Please complete them as soon as possible. Transportation companies will often withhold setting up transportation until these forms are completed. If you did not receive information about the 372 form, please reach out to your child's home district to inquire about this form and its completion.

We are excited for the upcoming school year and the growth of our PCS West community!
