A MESSAGE FROM OUR CEO

Dear PCSW Families,

It's been wonderful to settle back into our routines and see so many smiling faces both new and returning! We're thrilled to have everyone back.

In light of recent events, I wanted to take a moment to reassure you about the safety measures we have in place at PCSW to ensure the well-being of our students and staff. Our school is committed to maintaining a safe and secure environment for everyone. We have a dedicated Safety Committee Team that continuously evaluates and enhances our safety protocols. Our front entrance is equipped with a keyless fingerprint reader to control access. Each classroom is fitted with a Night Lock door stopper, which can be quickly engaged to prevent unwanted entry. We also have an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) located in the front hallway for medical emergencies.

For added security, we have installed over a dozen cameras throughout the campus, and our student information system includes features that allow for immediate emergency notifications. Additionally, our staff undergoes annual

ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) training to ensure they are well-prepared to respond to any critical situation. PCSW received a \$70,000 allocation from the PA Department of Education Grant through the PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency. These funds will be used to purchase more cameras and make additional safety upgrades. Additionally, each school in PA is required to have an established relationship with their local police department. The Economy Borough Chief of Police has visited and collaborated with our Principal and part time School Resource Officer. We expect that a representative from the Economy Borough Police Department will present to students on the importance of reporting anything unusual.

Should there be some kind of crisis or emergency in which the students and staff at PCS West need to relocate, all information would be communicated through PowerSchool rapid messaging. For this reason, please verify that all of your information is correct in Powerschool and that all beginning of the year documents are complete. The reunification site for PCS West is St. Josephs, 1020 W. State Street, Baden, PA 15005. Please know that your child's safety is our top priority, and we are continuously working to maintain a safe and supportive environment. If you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to reach out.

Finally, a heartfelt thank you to everyone who attended our Meet the Teacher Night. As a parent myself, I understand how busy the first few weeks of school can be, and I truly appreciate your time and commitment in making these evenings a priority.

It's CDT Testing Time!

The Pennsylvania Classroom Diagnostic Tools (CDT) are assessments given three times a year to students in grades 3-8. These assessments cover Reading, Writing, Mathematics, and Science. The CDTs help teachers understand how well students are grasping key skills and concepts based on Pennsylvania Core Standards. This information allows teachers to provide targeted instruction to address individual student's learning gaps. Results from the Fall CDT will be shared with families by the first week in October.


